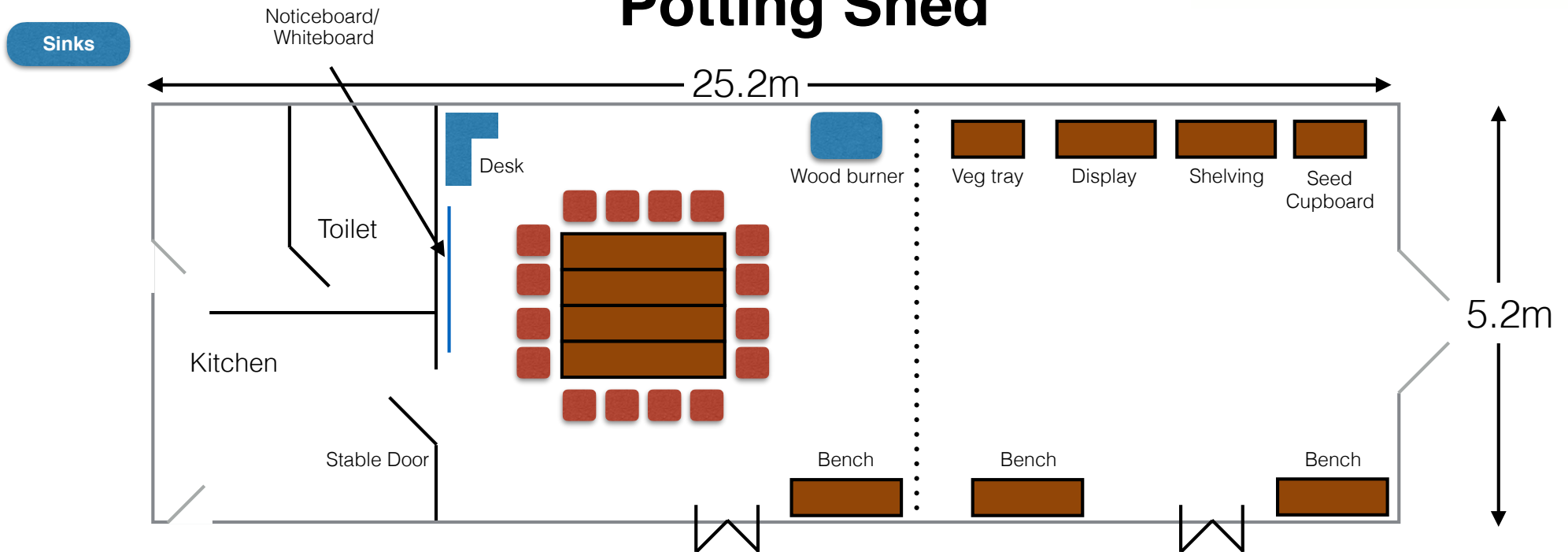


Potting Shed



Potting Shed = “A flexible multi-purpose space”

The aim of the layout of the potting shed is to allow for flexibility and to be able to be used by different groups in a variety of layouts. This will allow as many people as possible to use it.

Key Points agreed:

- **Walls** - Sealed and painted, with some large framed historical photo's of the garden
- **Floor** - Under the table area to be self levelled with screed and painted
- **Desk** - The desk will be included if it fits in the space when seen
- **Old Cropping Shed** - Shed itself to be removed but covered preparation area outside to be re-configured to better fit the area and may move to the other side of the path away from the potting shed
- **Tea & Storage Sheds** - To be agreed later if they are still required
- **Shelving** - Required for vegetable storage
- **Benches** - Needed for seed trays, tomatoes, chitting potatoes etc. in front of windows. One as a work bench.
- **Seating** - To be flexible to support differing layouts. Large table is made up of 4 bench tables for use in other layouts.
- **Heating** - A wood burner is needed for winter months, but must be installed by a qualified engineer
- **Sinks** - Outside sinks to be plumbed and drainage connected for washing pots, etc. Outside in location TBC.
